

CLEANING AND CARE | Plein Sud outdoor collection

For our outdoor collection we only use polypropylene (PP) technical yarns suitable for use in both collective and residential, indoor and/or outdoor environments. The PP yarn, due to its draining and drying properties, is also ideal for wet areas such as saunas, spas, hammams and swimming pools. Other features are high resistance to weathering and UV stability of the colours.

Recommendations.

We recommend the use of non-slip pads if the carpet is laid on extremely glossy floors. If the anti-slip is used indoors on floors with integrated heating, check that this does not stick or damage the floor over time due to the insulating effect of the rugs, in order to make it easier to dry the carpets from rainwater or moisture, lift them slightly off the floor.

To maintain a regular appearance, turn the carpet 2 to 3 times a year.

Cleaning.

It is important to clean the carpet at least once a week to prolong its life and colours. For ordinary cleaning we recommend the use of vacuum cleaners with soft brushes. Never use rotation brushes. For stains use a solution of cold water and neutral detergent for accurate cleaning, starting from the edges of the stain towards the centre. Rinse excess soap and allow to air dry. In case of strong stains, repeat cleaning until the stains are removed. Do not use hard brushes, abrasive tools, bleaching agents or solvents. Do not wash dry or with high pressure washers.

Stains.

Liquid stains should be removed immediately by dabbing the area with kitchen paper or a clean cloth.

Solid stains should be carefully scraped off with the tip of a knife or spoon.

Some general recommendations for the different types of stains are as follows

- a. Clean the stain from the edges to the centre, preventing it from spreading further.
- b. Test cleaning products in a small area of the carpet, better in a corner, to make sure they don't spoil the colors.
- c. Use only a small amount of detergent to avoid over impregnating the yarn.
- d. Apply the product with a moist sponge and rub gently. Avoid rubbing vigorously to avoid damaging the yarn.

Some stains are absorbed faster than others and become more difficult to remove.

If stains persist after these treatments or if the carpet is laid in areas of intense passage, we recommend that you bring the carpet to a professional wash.

*Dry cleaning: refers to the use of laundry solvents (alcohol or trieline) or specific sprays.

*Neutral detergents: use of wool soaps or water diluted Marseille soaps.

Professional cleaning.

If you decide to bring your Warli carpet to the laundry, please refer to them our cleaning instructions.

Avoid washing by industrial washing machines and centrifugal presses. Water washing is recommended for all our outdoor carpets.

Drying must be carried out by hanging the carpets on a rigid bar in the open air, without exposing them to direct sunlight. If drying is carried out in rooms with forced ventilation, the temperature must not exceed 45°C.
